poore of Ribworth Warwurt aforesaid and of Ribworth Beantwape
and Smeeton Westerby in the County of Ayr. Ten shillings a peire to
be paid by my Executor within one Month next after my deathe And
Lastly my debts and Legands being paid and funckall expenss
discharged all my goods chattels moneyes rent bonds bills Mortgaged
and personall estate whatsoever I give and bequeath to my aforesaid
son William Parker whom I make sole Executor of this my last will
and Testament revoking and making void all former and other wills
by me heretofore made In Witnesse whereof I the said William
Parker the Elder have hereunto set my hand and Seale this fiftenth
day of March Anno Dom 1687 William Parker Signed sealed
